## **CLASSES**

1	POT PLANT FLOWERING	Any flowering pot plant, excluding Fuchsias and Pelargoniums.
2	FLOWERING SHRUB/TREE	Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter. Three stems of one variety. (Not Hydrangeas)
3	HYDRANGEAS <i>Mop Heads</i>	Three heads, any one variety, same colour. Max 2 entries per exhibitor.
4	HYDRANGEAS Lace Caps	Three heads, any one variety, same colour. Max 2 entries per exhibitor
5	FLOWER ARRANGEMENT	An arrangement of flowers & foliage. Maximum 46 cms. (18 ins.) overall.
6	ROSES	One Spray or three blooms on separate stems.
7	DAHLIAS	Three stems, any variety.
8	FLOWERS	Minimum of three, maximum of five, stems or spikes same variety, any flower (Excluding Hydrangeas, Dahlias, Roses, or shrubs.)
9	SALADS & OR VEGETABLES	A collection of three distinct kinds of salads & or vegetables. <u>To be displayed in an area 38 x 30.5 cms. (15 x 12 ins.)</u> (May include Tomatoes)
10	HERBS	A collection of a minimum of three distinct varieties of herbs displayed in a Jam Jar.
11	SOFT FRUIT	One variety displayed on a dish or saucer Max diameter 15.2 cms. (6 ins.) (Excluding Tomatoes)
12	PELARGONIUMS	One pot plant. Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.
13	FUCHSIAS	One pot plant. Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.
14	POT PLANT FOLIAGE	Any pot plant consisting of foliage only. Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.
	PLANT IN A SMALLPOT	Any pot plant. Size of pot not to exceed 10 cms. (4 ins.) diameter.
16	MINI FLOWER ARRANGEMENT	An arrangement of any flowers and foliage in any container. Must not exceed 13 x 13 x 13 cms. (5 x 5 x 5 ins.) overall.
17	SPECIAL CLASS	Any Garden flowers in an arrangement including a Beer Bottle. <u>Max base size 30.5 cms. x 25.4 cms. (12 ins x 10 ins.)</u> Class sponsored by ROYAL OAK INN. SPECIAL PRIZE
18	CHILDREN'S CLASS	A: A Garden in a Tyre: To be grown & judged at school, with a
	Age 15 or under.	photograph provided for the Show.
	SPECIAL PRIZES.	<b>B:</b> Make a Bloom: A single flower head and stem, made of recycled materials: to be displayed in a bottle or jam jar at the show.
