| 1  | <b>POT PLANT<br/>FLOWERING</b>              | Any flowering pot plant, excluding Fuchsias and Pelargoniums.<br><i>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.</i>  |
| 2  | <b>FLOWERING<br/>SHRUB/TREE</b>             | Three stems of one variety.<br>(Not Hydrangeas)   |
| 3  | <b>HYDRANGEAS<br/>Mop Heads</b>             | Three heads, any one variety, same colour.<br><b>Max 2 entries per exhibitor.</b>   |
| 4  | <b>HYDRANGEAS<br/>Lace Caps</b>             | Three heads, any one variety, same colour.<br><b>Max 2 entries per exhibitor</b>  |
| 5  | <b>FLOWER<br/>ARRANGEMENT</b>               | An arrangement of flowers & foliage.<br><i>Maximum 46 cms. (18 ins.) overall.</i>   |
| 6  | <b>ROSES</b>                                | One Spray or three blooms on separate stems.  |
| 7  | <b>DAHLIAS</b>                              | Three stems, any one variety, same colour.  |
| 8  | <b>FLOWERS</b>                              | Minimum of three, maximum of five, stems or spikes same variety,<br>any flower (Excluding Hydrangeas, Dahlias, Roses, or shrubs.)   |
| 9  | <b>SALAD<br/>OR VEGETABLES</b>              | A collection of three distinct kinds of salad or vegetables.<br><i>To be displayed in an area 38 x 30.5 cms. (15 x 12 ins.)<br/>(May include Tomatoes)</i>                          |
| 10 | <b>HERBS</b>                                | A collection of a minimum of three distinct varieties of herbs<br>displayed in a Jam Jar.   |
| 11 | <b>SOFT FRUIT</b>                           | One variety displayed on a dish or saucer<br><i>Max diameter 15.2 cms. (6 ins.) (Excluding Tomatoes)</i>  |
| 12 | <b>PELARGONIUMS</b>                         | One pot plant. <i>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.</i>  |
| 13 | <b>FUCHSIAS</b>                             | One pot plant. <i>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.</i>  |
| 14 | <b>POT PLANT FOLIAGE</b>                    | Any pot plant consisting of foliage only.<br><i>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms. (8 ins.) diameter.</i>  |
| 15 | <b>PLANT IN A<br/>SMALLPOT</b>              | Any pot plant. <i>Size of pot not to exceed 10 cms. (4 ins.) diameter.</i>  |
| 16 | <b>MINI FLOWER<br/>ARRANGEMENT</b>          | An arrangement of any flowers and foliage in any container.<br><i>Must not exceed 13 x 13 x 13 cms. (5 x 5 x 5 ins.) overall.</i>   |
| 17 | <b>SPECIAL CLASS</b>                        | Any Garden flowers in an arrangement with a Beer Bottle.<br><i>Max base size 30.5 cms. x 25.4 cms. (12 ins x 10 ins.)</i><br><b>Class sponsored by ROYAL OAK INN. SPECIAL PRIZE</b> |
| 18 | <b>CHILDREN'S CLASS<br/>Age 15 or under</b> | Mini Garden in a container <i>max size 16 cms. x 22 cms. (6¼ ins x 8¾ins)</i> (e.g. Mushroom box) <b>SPECIAL PRIZES.</b>  |
