15 PLANT IN A SMALLPOT Any pot plant. Size of pot not to exceed 10 cms. (4 ins.) diameter.

An arrangement of any flowers and foliage in any container. 16 MINI FLOWER Must not exceed $13 \times 13 \times 13$ cms. $(5 \times 5 \times 5)$ ins.) overall. ARRANGEMENT
