| 1 | POT PLANT FLOWERING | Any flowering pot plant, excluding Fuchsias and Pelargoniums
<u>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms (8 ins) diameter</u> |
| 2 | FLOWERING SHRUB/TREE | Three stems of one variety (Not Hydrangeas) |
| 3 | HYDRANGEAS
<i>Mop Heads & Paniculata</i> | Three heads, any one variety, same colour
Max 2 entries per exhibitor |
| 4 | HYDRANGEAS
<i>Lace Caps</i> | Three heads, any one variety, same colour
Max 2 entries per exhibitor |
| 5 | FLOWER ARRANGEMENT | An arrangement of flowers & foliage
<u>Maximum 46 cms (18 ins) overall</u> |
| 6 | ZINNIAS | Five cut stems of any variety. |
| 7 | DAHLIAS | Three stems, any variety |
| 8 | FLOWERS | Minimum of three, maximum of five, stems or spikes same variety any Flower (Excluding Hydrangeas, Dahlias, Zinnias, or shrubs.) |
| 9 | SALADS | A collection of three distinct kinds of salads.
(May include one variety of Tomato)
<u>To be displayed within an area 38 x 30.5 cms (15 x 12 ins) or a round 38cms (15ins) in diameter</u> |
| 10 | VEGETABLES | A collection of three distinct kinds of Vegetables. (May include Rhubarb) <u>To be displayed within an area 38 x 30.5 cms (15 x 12ins) or a round 38cms (15ins) in diameter</u> |
| 11 | HERBS | A collection of a minimum of three distinct varieties of herbs.
<u>Displayed in a jam jar</u> |
| 12 | PELARGONIUMS | One pot plant. <u>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms (8 ins) diameter</u> |
| 13 | FUCHSIAS | One pot plant. <u>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms (8 ins) diameter</u> |
| 14 | POT PLANT FOLIAGE | Any pot plant consisting of foliage only
<u>Size of pot not to exceed 20.4 cms (8 ins) diameter.</u> |
| 15 | PLANT IN A SMALL POT | Any pot plant. <u>Size of pot not to exceed 10 cms (4 ins) diameter</u> |
| 16 | MINI FLOWER ARRANGEMENT | An arrangement with foliage in any container
<u>Must not exceed 13 x 13 x 13 cms (5 x 5 x 5 ins overall)</u> |
| 17 | ARRANGEMENT IN A JUG | Using any garden flowers. Container to be supplied by exhibitor
Class sponsored by ROYAL OAK INN. Special Prize |
| 18 | CHILDREN'S CLASS | Small paper plate (20cms dia) decorated with a flower and/or vegetable theme |

NOTES: The Gordon Cross Trophy is awarded to the member gaining the most points in the show. Exhibits to be staged between 10.00am and 12.00 noon are limited to three per person in any class.

See also 3 & 4 above. **Any deemed Not-According-To-Schedule, or Late: will be disallowed.**

All entries are to be grown by the exhibitor for a minimum of three months, except for flower arrangements.

Please name your varieties wherever possible. Please take note of the specified dimensions.

To win any trophy exhibitors must be Society members for 3 months before the day of the show.

All trophies are perpetual and are to be returned for next year's show.

Exhibits by non-members, at £1.00 each, are welcome.
